COMMUNICATION:

Information was shared regarding the NTSB Meeting that was held in East Palestine on June 25th:

- The controlled burn was determined to be unnecessary
- The "111" cars that were transporting the butyl acrylate and likely started the fire, have been in a slow phase-out for many years, but progress has been without immediacy previously

Darlington Township continues to request from the PA Governor's Office for the health monitoring as established in the EPA/DOJ Settlement re: Clean Water Act extend well beyond the two-mile radius currently established.

Darlington Township's Solicitor also reached out to the Plaintiff attorney for the pending private settlement in an attempt to extend the "opt-out" period given the recent information released by NTSB. This request was denied.

The Fire Department has requested upgrades to their technology including mobile wi-fi in some of their vehicles. The Township will work with the Fire Department to ensure that these upgrades are available to them.

Bill Shaffer of Oakdale Road wanted to compliment the new paving of the parking lot and walking trail and inquired the amount spent and if a grant was used to pay for the entire project. Also had a question on spraying for mosquitoes in the Township.

Lori Abels of Cannelton Road inquired about receiving late tax bills and if the Township can assist her in receiving the bills on time.
